

GUEST passes

1. Guest Passes are not transferable to other members. The member to whom the passes were issued **MUST** be present when using a Guest Pass.
 2. Each member must sign in and deposit one (1) **FULLY COMPLETED (part 2) guest pass in the box** beside the sign in book in the clubhouse for **every Person entering the facilities. One guest pass is required for each day the guest is at the Range.**
 3. The guest must have **part 1 (small Stub) of the guest pass visible at all times while on the Range.**
 4. Non-Member Minors are permitted to shoot at the Range with a valid guest pass. The Member assumes full responsibility for the Minor's actions.
 5. Only one (1) guest may shoot at a time while under the **immediate and direct control of the Club member.**
 6. **CLUB MEMBERS MAY NOT SHOOT WHILE SUPERVISING A GUEST UNLESS OTHERWISE PERMITTED BY THE RANGE MASTER OR EVENT DIRECTOR!**
 7. The Member must have their membership card readily visible at all times.
 8. Compliance of all range rules is the full responsibility of the club Member. Violation of any Range rule by a guest will result in the immediate suspension of all privileges and reinstatement will be at the sole discretion of the Executive.
 9. A Guest may use this facility a maximum of **two (2) times per year, with the exception of** attending advertized, invitational (Sanctioned) matches. The club will provide guest passes to non-members for all sanctioned events.
 10. Guest passes are not available to new members until completion of probationary period or approved by the Executive.
- ALL GUEST PASSES EXPIRE December**

- The *GUEST Pass* is both the Insurance cover and CFO requirement.
- If you do not fill this in correctly and deposit in box your guest is **NOT** insured and the Club is **NOT** liable.

Shooting Clubs and Shooting Ranges Regulations (SOR/98-212) Sections and Schedules Section 14 : Records

- 14.** (1) The operator of an approved shooting club shall keep records, with respect to the following users of restricted firearms or prohibited firearms, that include
- (a) with respect to a member or officer of the club
 - (i) his or her name, address and phone number,
 - (ii) his or her membership card number, and
 - (iii) the number of his or her licence to possess firearms or, if one does not exist, his or her date of birth; and
 - (b) with respect to a guest of a member or officer of the club
 - (i) the information required in subparagraph (a)(i), and
 - (ii) the number of his or her licence to possess firearms, if one exists.
 - (b) (2) Every record made under subsection (1) must be maintained for at least six years.
 - (c) (3) At the chief firearms officer's request, the operator of the approved shooting club shall submit to the chief firearms officer a report containing all or any requested part of the information described in subsection (1).
